## Southland Transportation Ltd.



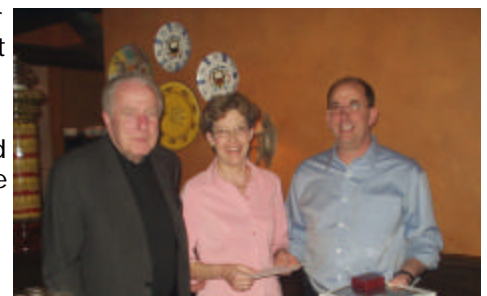
