Year after year our passenger surveys indicate positive satisfaction levels in the high 70 percent to low 80 percent range. Buses are the most fuel efficient form of transportation. With the high cost of fuels and the need for the Province to do its part in achieving Canada's commitments to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, the future for bus transportation in Saskatchewan should be very positive.
